Online Learning

We believe that all students should have access to consistent learning content, whether they are learning at school, or at home.

This **Rose Park @ Home** Guide provides an overview of the online learning platforms for Term 2.



General

- Relevant school-based ICT user agreements and policies regarding safety online continue to be in place,
- Parent queries and questions should be sent to classroom teachers via email, and will be responded to within a 48 hour period,
- Teachers will continue to collaborate to ensure continuity across year levels,
- General communications from the school will continue through Edsmart and SkoolBag,
- A timetable (framework) for the week, outlining the week's learning, will be posted at the start of each week,

What can parents/ caregivers do to help?

To support student well-being, it is important that a sense of routine is maintained. Ensuring students have a balance of work, rest and sleep will help establish 'new' normal routines, including wake up times, set time for school work, and opportunities for fresh air and exercise. We look forward to families supporting their children by:

- establishing routines and expectations. Each teacher will provide advice, as well as a guide, for what your child should be doing during the day,
- finding a quiet space for your child to work (*this location should **NOT** be the students' bedroom*),
- providing a level of supervision appropriate to your child's stage of development,
- asking how their learning is progressing - helping your child to manage and pace their work,
- making sure students have breaks and drink plenty of water,
- monitoring communications from teachers,
- monitoring technology use for online safety,
- monitoring the time students spend online.



Reception - Year 3

- Junior Primary (R-3) teachers will use Seesaw to keep in contact with parents at various times throughout the day. Seesaw will also be the platform for students to submit learning when required,
- *Padlet* (class pinboard) will be the content delivery platform, with resources linked/uploaded,
- Each class *Padlet* will have its own password protected 'Homeroom', where teachers and students can interact in a safe online environment. Within this homeroom, students are encouraged to 'sign in' with a simple post each day,
- Specialist classes will contribute to online learning content each week through their specific subject *Padlet*,
- Each morning, in the Homeroom, teachers will outline the daily routine with a brief recorded video message,
- Throughout the day, students can post questions and comments through *Padlet*,
- Parents are asked **NOT** to share the class *Padlet* password (*it would be similar to inviting strangers into your child's classroom*).





Year 4 - 7

- Year 4-7 students are already familiar with our Learning Management System, 'GSuite for Education',
- 'Real time' interaction will be in the form of an online virtual classroom via 'Google Meet' (*your teacher will establish meeting times in the Classroom*). Students will be expected to log into the Classroom and join the morning 'Meeting' between 9:10 - 9:20 each morning (*video and audio muted*), where the class teacher will mark the roll,
- **IF**, at any time, students are required to turn on their camera/microphone, or submit a photo within the meeting, a parent/caregiver should be present in the room,
- At all times while online, all students must be dressed appropriately and it would be preferred, *in their Rose Park school uniform*,
- Students will be made aware of teacher expectations during classroom learning activities, and students who are unable to follow the guidelines will be removed. In the event of continued inappropriate behaviour, parents will be contacted, and the students' @roseparkps.com.au Google account will be suspended (*students losing access to their Rose Park Google Classrooms/ Drive*),
- Curriculum content and resources will be uploaded to 'Classrooms', and classroom teachers will be available to answer *student* questions, within the Classroom, at various times throughout the day,
- Active supervision is strongly advised, for all students, when using their Chromebook at home.
